Save the Monarchs and Plant More Milkweed!

Pollinators are in decline & Ohio is critical for Monarchs

- * While in migration, Monarchs both feed and lay eggs in Ohio.
- * To secure Monarch populations, Ohio needs viable pollinator habitat.



- * Milkweed is the Monarch's ONLY host plant.
- * The seed pods are picked in early fall when the pod and seeds are both brown.
- * The collected seeds are used to establish new plantings.
