



**NOTICE TO ALL OWNERS/USERS**

It is unlawful to break any lead and wire security seal placed on a meter and/or register. Section 1327.61 of the Ohio Revised Code states: "No person shall remove any tag, seal or mark" officially placed by a state or local weights and measures sealer without his/her authorization.

Should it at any time be necessary to break any security seal it shall be the responsibility of the owner/user of the device to complete the information below and mail it to:
